



QUEENIE MILLS' VISION COMES TO LIFE

Queenie Mills, PhD, never dwelled on her grants, awards, or publications, though they were considerable. Queenie was a pioneer of the academic study of the human-animal bond. She retired from the UI as Professor Emerita of Child Development, head of the Department of Human Development and Family Ecology, and Director of the Child Development Laboratory. In her early career, she was a research assistant to Dr. Benjamin Spock.

In 1964 Queenie started one of the country's first intervention programs for pre-school children from low-income families. The following year she was a member of the group that launched the National Head Start Program. In 1978, she was the recipient of the Paul A. Funk Award for her development of a significant interdisciplinary program of teaching and research.

That same year she joined the CCHS Board of Directors, where her vision, compassion and council over the next 20 years played a major role in shaping the Champaign County Humane Society into what it is today. Also in 1978, she started the Pet-a-Pet program where volunteers took pets on weekly visits to residents of Champaign-Urbana nursing homes. She went

on to devote the rest of her life's work to convincing society that interactions with animals make people feel better, and to provide that experience to those who could benefit the most - children and the elderly or infirm.

In 1998, with a lead gift of \$40,000, Queenie Mills, PhD, established the Queenie Mills Endowment Fund with a dual purpose: to provide for the creation of a memorial garden, where people could honor the memory of their beloved pets, and to fund future operations and capital improvements at CCHS. The recent landscape makeover of the humane society's grounds and the

installation of the Queenie Mills Memorial Wall bring Queenie Mills' vision to life.

Humane Society Executive Director, Mary "Tief" Tiefenbrunn explained how CCHS honored Queenie Mills' legacy. "The landscape design and memorial wall were conceived with Queenie's ideals in mind. The paths, trees, and benches around the shelter offer a pleasant environment for people and dogs to spend time together. The Memorial Wall provides what Queenie wanted for every pet owner who grieves the loss of an animal friend - a way to honor that memory with a permanent marker and to be surrounded by people who understand the depth of that loss."

We are now offering custom-engraved granite plaques for \$500 or \$750 (depending on size), to memorialize beloved pets on the wall. Plaques will be permanently installed on the stone wall leading to the humane society entrance. Funds raised through the purchase of memorial plaques will support the Society's programs and services.

On the day the wall was dedicated, a dear friend of CCHS who knew Queenie Mills personally posted the following message to Queenie on her Facebook page: "Today's Champaign County Humane Society's programs, outreach, standards of animal care, and staff have exceeded your wildest expectations. I hope you know that." We're humbled by these kind words and will remain forever grateful to Queenie Mills for her legacy.

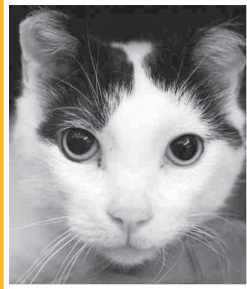

2015 GIANT Garage Sale Another GIANT Success

Something extraordinary happened recently: Over the two weeks leading up to the Memorial Day weekend, 150 of the best volunteers around transformed the cavernous Kesler Hall at the Champaign County Fairgrounds into a thriving – and overflowing – mercantile to benefit the homeless pets cared for by the Champaign County Humane Society.

This year's GIANT Garage Sale earned \$62,000 for their care.

It starts with a box. Inside may be books or games or clothes or antique toys. Or a mystery item that gets put in the Command Center with a note: "What is this?" (It turned out to be a carrying case for ear buds.)

Car trunks pop open, and two or three volunteers, Schnuck's shopping carts in tow, swarm and empty them and the back seats. A garden hose; a stereo system; a box of assorted housewares, including a set of six matching mugs; five wine glasses and service for eight in Pfaltzgraff's Village pattern; a Christmas tree wrapped in multicolored lights; a Billy Morrow Jackson print framed in light oak; a set of beginner golf clubs. Over and over again.

How many cars and trucks and trailers? Hundreds, over the 21 hours donations are accepted over four days.

What brings the donors? Many tell us they have been collecting their donations for us since the last sale. They want to support CCHS, telling us of the pets they've adopted. Some dogs are riding shotgun. Heads are petted, ears are ruffled and stories are swapped between donors and volunteers.

What brings the volunteers? They, too, want to give back for their companion animals adopted from CCHS – Riley, Zuni, Barney, Petey, Shadow, Sadie, Sidney and many, many others. They want to support the mission of CCHS. But they're also up for the challenge of unloading, sorting, delivering, organizing and pricing what's in those hundreds of boxes.

And they're up for recreating the CCHS Garage Sale community year after year. It's a special bond we have with each other. Friendships bloom among the conversations over those piles of donations. The volunteers say they look forward to the sale each year – "I love working at the Garage Sale!" It couldn't happen without their devotion.
